

Own Credo - What is important to you

I believe in... What do you believe in that is important? You can think of something idealistic, like God, or otherwise, like human kindness, or something big in the world, or practical, perhaps relating to wealth and poverty or war and peace. What are you interested in on the bigger stage? It should be something important to you that has certain consequences.

And in... Thus something that comes from your big matter of importance. It can extend that matter of importance.

In practice this means... Something in detail that is consistent with 1 and 2 above.

In addition... Something that continues the point above. *This is optional.*

In the future there could be... What practical steps may happen if your belief was to realise itself?

To do this we need... What practical bodies would or could carry this out?

We should all behave better by... Give a moral statement.

And in the future there will be, if one day, ... Give a hoped for outcome that you would like to see even if it does not happen.

Example:

I believe in the ending of world starvation.

And in the right of everyone to eat well.

In practice this means food is made available to all who need it.

In addition, no animals should be eaten.

In the future there could be immediate responses to crop failures.

To do this we need the World Food Organisation.

We should behave better sharing what we do not need.

And in the future, there will be, if one day, no hunger anymore.

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
