



### Changes Suggested to Transport for London Routes

All London Underground routes are called lines and London Overground routes are either Chords or Spokes. A Chord usually goes around the centre and generates outer cross routes. They tend to be longer and slower too but also busier.

Longer and limited stop Transport for London routes are not shown but their interchanges are shown as are those with British Rail (and the latter take priority).
